









Zwaan, Roadmap to Noord Rombout Oomen en Fleur Lamers, 2014

Summary

The book, with proportional dimensions of the original work of art, was created on the occasion of the unveiling of the monumental art banner (52 x 25 m) on the A'DAM Tower (formerly Overhoeks Tower) in Amsterdam North on 26th March 2014. The original painting, oil on canvas 2.27 x 4.80 m, with the Swan, coat of arms of Nieuwendam, created by artist Rombout Oomen, is inspired by the painting of Jan Asselijn, which is exhibited in the Rijksmuseum.

The painting has been revealed on 29th March 2014 by Rob Post, former president Stadsdeel Noord and has been donated to Stadsdeel Noord.

The book contains the description of the creation of the artwork and essays by Bas Kok, Anne Marie Hoogland and Noorje de Leij on the history of Amsterdam-Noord, the meaning of the swan as a symbol of Amsterdam-Noord and the role of the swan in the art of painting.
